3. Co-Treasurer's Report –
 - a. Dabo: About \$57,225.91 cash on hand, have spent about \$11k this school year. BTG doing well--have raised \$53,549.76 in direct parent donations and \$9,404 in corporate matches to date.

 - a. Tiffany: Brief overview of the CEC, an education policy advisory group that meets once per month and helps provide input about educational decision making. Anyone can attend the meetings; go to their website to sign up for their email list.
